Roast Duck

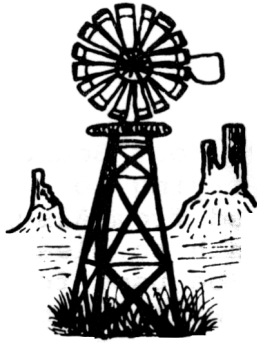
RECIPE OF THE MONTH

4-5 lb. duck. Mix together the following and rub on the inside and outside of the duck:

3 Teaspoons salt
1 Teaspoon papper
1/2 Teaspoon garlic salt or powder
2 Teaspoons paprika

Place duck in oven bag, cut slits on top of bag, then pour in the following mixture: 1/2 Cup Orange juice; 1 Tablespoon Wesson oil; 2 Tablespoons honey. Bake for two hours at 350°.

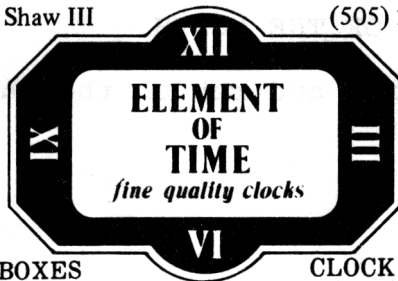
